

ZONING CERTIFICATES

Why do I Need a Zoning Certificate?

A Zoning Certificate ensures all construction within Miami Township complies with its zoning regulations. A Miami Township Zoning Certificate is necessary to obtain a Clermont County Building Permit.

For What Types of Projects?

A Zoning Certificate is required for all new construction. This includes:

- New Homes
- Residential Additions
- Fences
- New Businesses
- Home Occupations
- Swimming Pools
- Storage Sheds

- Detached Garage
- New Commercial and Industrial Buildings
- Commercial and Industrial Additions
- Signs, Permanent and Temporary
- The list is not all inclusive, but does indicate the most common projects which require a Certificate. Zoning Certificates are not normally required for remodeling projects such as remodeling a kitchen or bath, new windows or a new roof.

What Do I Need to Obtain a Zoning Certificate?

To obtain a Zoning Certificate you must complete an application form. This is a one page form that provides basic information on the proposed project. In addition to the application form you must provide one (1) copy of a site plan and one (1) copy of the plans for your project. There is an application fee required for each application.

How Long Does it Take to Get a Zoning Certificate?

Provided the application is complete, most Zoning Certificates can be issued within 48 hours depending on work volume. Commercial, Industrial and multifamily projects will require more time due to a requirement for a site plan review. Zoning Certificates for these projects can be issued in approximately two (2) weeks depending on the complexity of the project.

Where Do I Get a Zoning Certificate?

Zoning Certificates can be obtained at the Miami Township Department of Community Development located at 6101 Meijer Drive, Milford, Ohio 45150. Office Hours are from 8:00AM to 4:30 PM, Monday through Friday.
